Admission to AIM II is by lottery. To apply, students must be:

- At least 15 years old at the time of enrollment
- At least one grade behind and have completed 7th grade

Preference is given to students who are:

- Involved in the juvenile or criminal justice system
- Homeless or in transitional housing
- Involved in foster care or child protective services
- Siblings of current students
- Residents of the community school district
