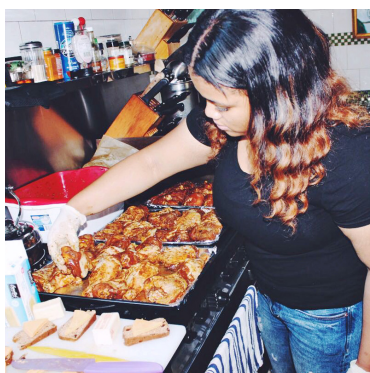


NEW VISIONS AIM CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL I

OUR ENGAGEMENT PATHWAYS ARE:

- 1. COLLEGE PREP:** Designed to engage students who have the desire to attain a college degree upon graduation.
- 2. ARTS & ATHLETICS:** For current or aspiring artists and athletes passionate about developing the skills necessary to ensure a foundation in the arts or athletics.
- 3. 21ST CENTURY WORKFORCE:** For students who aspire to pursue a career immediately after graduation, and want to be equipped with necessary skills.
- 4. VOCATIONAL PATHWAY:** For students who desire to learn or become certified in a trade or particular hands-on profession.

ADMISSION TO AIM I IS BY LOTTERY. TO APPLY, STUDENTS MUST BE:

- At least 15 years old at the time of enrollment
- At least one grade behind and have completed 7th grade

PREFERENCE IS GIVEN TO STUDENTS WHO ARE:

- Involved in the juvenile or criminal justice system
- Homeless or in transitional housing
- Involved in foster care or child protective services
- Siblings of current students
- Residents of the community school district
